Requirements & Eligibility

- Maintain enrollment at MSU
- MSU students who have experienced foster care, kinship care, homelessness, or were otherwise independent prior to age 18 are eligible to receive FAME services
- Maintain regular engagement
 with FAME Program staff

*Some services may have additional requirements.

- Pell Grants
- Education and Training Voucher (ETV) Funds
- MET Fostering Futures Scholarship Funds
